

Taliban forcing Afghan women to marry ultras

As the Taliban is gaining ground in Afghanistan by capturing many key cities in the country, the terror group is now forcing women to get married to its terrorists, a media report said on Thursday.

Afghans are also witnessing the execution of captured soldiers and unprovoked attacks on civilians by the Taliban in its recent captured areas.

Afghans pouring into Kabul and those still in Taliban-held areas say they have witnessed unprovoked attacks on civilians and executions of captured soldiers. In addition, they say, Taliban have demanded that communities turn over unmarried women to become "wives" for their terrorists — a form of sexual violence, human-rights groups say, *The Wall Street Journal* reported on Thursday.

The Taliban had publicly pledged to be magnanimous in victory, assuring government officials, troops and the people



of Afghanistan that they have nothing to fear as ever-larger swaths of the country fall under their control. But their actions say otherwise, *The Wall Street Journal* added.

On Thursday, the US Embassy in Kabul had criticised the Taliban as it had received reports of the Taliban executing members of the Afghan military who had surrendered. "Deeply disturbing & could constitute war crimes," the embassy said on Twitter.

The Taliban has gained control over many key cities in the region. On Thursday night,

the terror group claimed that it took control of the country's second-largest city Kandahar after seizing the governor's office and other administrative buildings in the city. So far, the terror group has captured 12 provincial capitals in the country.

The terror group is extensively fighting with the Afghan government forces in an attempt to seize key cities and grab power soon after the US forces withdrawal from Afghanistan under a peace deal signed between the Taliban and Washington.

Al Qaeda will probably come back: UK Min on Afghanistan crisis

London: Afghanistan is "heading towards civil war" and terror group Al Qaeda "will probably come back" as the security situation in the region continues to deteriorate, UK Defence Secretary Ben Wallace said on Friday.

The Cabinet minister was addressing UK media outlets on the government's decision to send in approximately 600 additional troops to facilitate the safe exit of remaining UK personnel in Afghanistan as the Taliban onslaught gathers momentum.

"I think we are heading towards a civil war," he told the BBC. With reference to the US withdrawal of troops from Afghanistan since May, he told 'Sky News': "I'm absolutely worried that failed states are breeding grounds for those types of people. Of course I am worried, it is why I said I felt this was not the right time or decision to make because, of course, Al Qaeda will probably come back, certainly would like that type of breeding ground."

Washington: Rapid Taliban conquests across Afghanistan led the Biden administration on Friday to rush 3,000 fresh troops to the Kabul airport to help with a partial evacuation

of the US Embassy in the capital and send thousands more to the region, to be on standby and speed airlifts for Afghans who worked with the American military.

Stoltenberg says NATO troubled by Taliban blitz

Brussels: The NATO chief says the military alliance is troubled by the Taliban offensive in Afghanistan and is warning the insurgents that they won't be considered legitimate by the West if they seize the country by force.

NATO Secretary-General Jens Stoltenberg told reporters after chairing talks on Friday with NATO ambassadors that the "allies are deeply concerned about the high levels of violence caused by the Taliban's offensive, including attacks on civilians, targeted killings, and reports of other serious human rights abuses."

He says "the Taliban need to understand that they will not be recognized by the international community if they take the country by force," and that NATO is "committed to supporting a political solution to the conflict."

Mysterious 'kill list' rattles Pak

A Pakistani parliamentary committee has ordered for a probe into a so-called "kill list" that mentions a number of public figures in the country, days after a former Taliban operative verified its existence and a leading British newspaper reported it.

The Committee, headed by Opposition Pakistan Peoples Party (PPP) leader Shazia Marri, has directed the Interior Secretary to have an urgent meeting with senators Farhatullah Babar and Afrasiab Khattak for their inputs in the probe, reported the Dawn newspaper on Friday. The names of both senators figured on the "kill list".

The panel has forwarded a

month-old Facebook post of former Taliban spokesperson Ehsanullah Ehsan, in which the "kill list" is clearly mentioned.

In the post, Ehsan said he was asked to lead a "death squad" to eliminate "some individuals".

The "kill list", according to Ehsan, included the names of former senators Farhatullah Babar, Afrasiab Khattak, Syed Alam Mehsum and Mufti Kifayatullah.

Farhatullah Babar said: "Ehsanullah Ehsan is no ordinary person. He is a former spokesperson for Tehreek-i-Taliban Pakistan (TTP) who later formed a splinter group, Jamaatul Ahrar, both designated as terror outfits. He has claimed responsibility for a number of deadly attacks in Pakistan."

RUSSIA BUS EXPLOSION KILLS 2, INJURES 22

Moscow: A second person has died in southwestern Russia following an explosion on a city bus that also injured another 20 people, officials said Friday. Authorities said Thursday's blast on the bus in the city of Voronezh was caused by leaky gas equipment. No trace of chemical explosives was found, they said.

Altamonte Springs (US): A toddler found an unsecured, loaded handgun inside an apartment and fatally shot a woman while she was on a work-related video call, police in central Florida said.

El-Arish (Egypt): A roadside bomb exploded late on Thursday in the restive northern part of the Sinai Peninsula, killing seven members of Egypt's security forces, security officials said.
